- Fulfill all course requirements in their individual departments by the time they graduate, in addition to the units required for the honors program.
- Complete DDRL 189 Honors Research Methods in the spring quarter of their junior year (3 units). Applicants should, therefore, plan quarters abroad accordingly. While some exceptions are made we encourage students to be on campus spring term of their junior year. DDRL 190 Honors Research Workshop (3 units per quarter, repeatable for credit) in the fall and winter quarters of their senior year. In addition to required courses, admitted students may earn up to 10 units through independent study with their advisor during their senior year for their completed thesis. Please note that this will not count towards major requirements in the student's respective department.
